Animals have always been an important part of art. Even before humans painted pictures of people, they decorated cave walls with deer, horses, and buffalo.

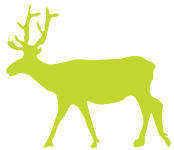
## GLASS SHAPED LIKE ANIMALS

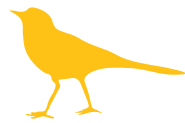

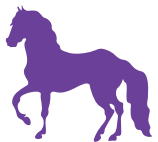
